The History of the Jaguar Club of Ohio Concours:

The Concours is an important event for the Jaguar Club of Ohio (JCO), that dates back with its first Concours d'Elegance that was held in 1972. Back when it all started, the few members wanted to show their Jaguars for competition. The few members did research and found the Jaguar Clubs of North America (JCNA), that was incorporated back in 1954, which is the hub of Jaguar enthusiasts from Canada, Mexico, the United States and around the world. Presently there are 67 Jaguar Clubs listed with JCNA. As a social organization with a common interest in the Jaguar marque, JCNA strives to provide members with the widest range of services and activities for those with an enthusiasm for all Jaguars, both old and new. JCO has kept up the tradition all these years for our members and other Jaguar Clubs so that they may enter their automobiles in our Concours in competition, in the Champion Class or the Driven Class for JCNA scores. All Concours held must meet all the regulations and rules set by JCNA as a competing event, just as Slaloms and Rallies, whereby they must be pre-approved, (Sanctioned) by JCNA before that event would be allowed to enter scoring for competition events against other competing Jaguar Clubs. Certified Judges must also adhere to all the rules and regulations while judging cars, which entails training, yearly update testing and reviews of all yearly rule book changes.

My point of view, conducting concours is that it must be well planned and organized, fun for all participants and spectators, fair and honest judging according to the rule books of JCNA, and in a setting that is conducive to upholding a special decorum for the Jaguar marque. Very importantly, donations to our charities; Sub-Zero Missions, New Directions, as well as give a donation to Ursuline College to thank them for the use of the building and grounds for the JCO Concours and EAS.

I have already started on our 52nd Concours d' Elegance for Saturday, August 2, 2025. For this next Concours I would like to set up volunteer teams, since all our volunteers have mastered the operations of working in certain areas of their expertise. I will be contacting volunteers in April and May to discuss ideas that they may have to making this event even better than ever.

We hope that you enjoyed the Concours and EAS event and hope that you will join us again next year on Saturday, August 2, 2025.

Keep in mind, that we are always looking for more volunteers as the number of participants grow for both the JCO Concours and the European Auto Shows in the future.

Our second big event for the year was our annual JCO picnic that was held on Sunday, August 25, 2024. Thanks to Marty and Jeanine Kukla for organizing this great time for all JCO members, family and friends.

• The final Jaguar F-type made at the brand's manufacturing facility in Castle Bromwich will join the Jaguar Heritage collection – 50 years to the day since the last Jaguar E-type drove off the production line. The final F-type is a 5.0 litre V8 Convertible in Giola Green with a black roof and a Tan Windsor leather interior – similar to that of the final E-type Series III Convertible built in 1974 and registered as HDU 555N.

This special F-type will be handed to the Jaguar Daimler Heritage Trust. It will join its E-type predecessor in the official Jaguar Heritage collection and take part in a series of special events and activities this year.

Just as the last E-type in 1974 heralded the birth of the radical Jaguar XJ-S, the final F-type has been produced as Jaguar readies an even bolder transformation – spearheaded by a four-door electric GT that promises to be a copy of nothing when it is revealed in 2025.

The F-type was first launched as a convertible in 2013 and was Jaguar's first two-seat sports car in almost 40 years. The coupé made its debut the following year.

87,731 F-types have been produced, and it will continue to be available until early 2025. JDHT records show that Jaguar produced 72,528 E-types, ending with a special run of 50 cars. Both cars will reside in the JDHT at Gaydon.

The F-type will be available to buy until early 2025, as production ends at Castle Bromwich.

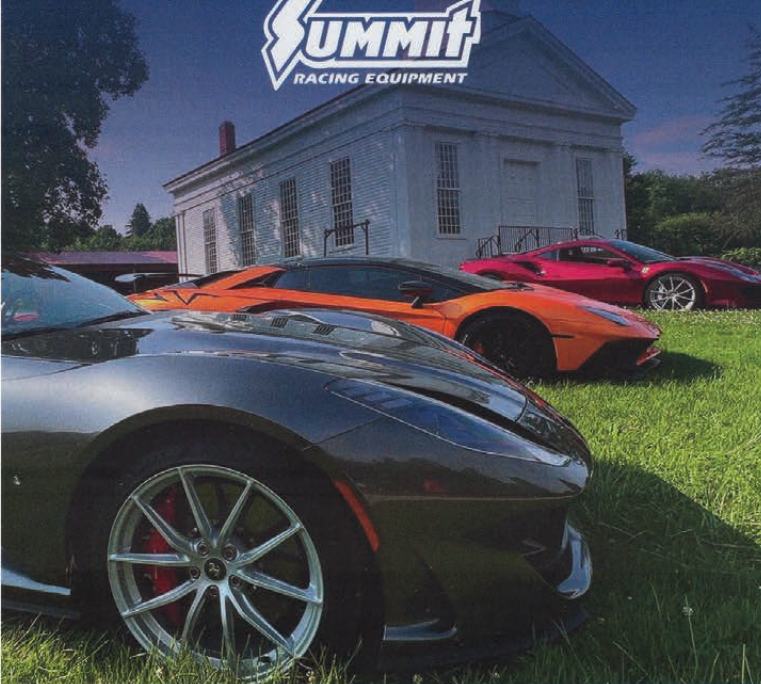

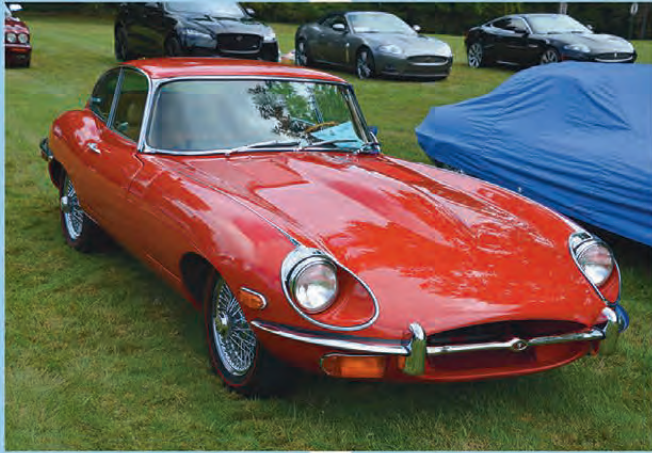

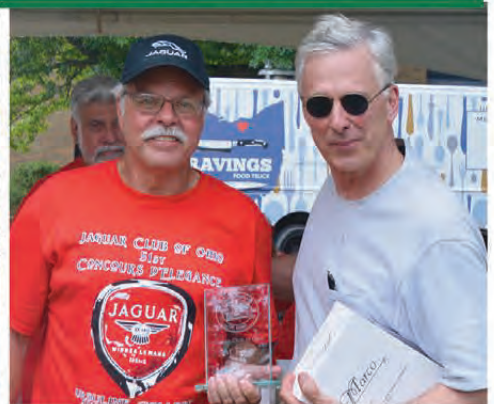
