





















Jaguars at the Mille Miglia, photos by John and Linda Price

In June Linda and I traveled to Italy for 2 weeks. We spent time in Venice, Milan, and Brescia.

We went to Bescia to see the start of the Mille Miglia. For those unfamiliar with the Mille Miglia, it is a classic car rally that celebrates the original open road race held from 1927 to 1957. The race traveled from Brescia to Rome and back (roughly 1000 miles, hence the name Mille Miglia) non-stop. Stirling Moss set the all time record completing the race in 1955 at an average of nearly 100 miles per hour.

To enter the classic rally you have to have a car that would've been eligible for the original races.

The cars you see are amazing and museum worthy. 1930s Bugattis mix with 1950s Ferraris. Little Italian garage made specials mix with giant 1930s Bentleys. You'll see cars you've never seen before. And of course, there are Jaguars. XK120s, 140s, C and D-Types, and custom bodied ones as well.

Brescia itself becomes one big celebration and party around this event.

I highly recommend going to see the Mille Miglia. Oh, and the rest of Italy pretty awesome too.




