XJS-C Photo Shoot at The Castle House



This year is the 50th Anniversary of the XJS. We needed to find a poster car that would be appropriate for the anniversary. Checking our member roster, we identified all of the XJS models owned in the club. Then we narrowed it down to Thomas Scahel's 1988 XJS-C Cabriolet V12. Our logic was that it was the oldest XJS in the club, and owned by one of our long-time members.

After identifying the car, we then had to find an appropriate place to take photos of the car. We always want a background that will complement its English heritage. So, then the research started, first on the internet to identify historic buildings in the area. Some locations were identified, and then the drives to check the location in person. Not satisfied with what we found, I started looking for historic homes. The searches always led me to realtor listings for "English style homes for sale". Then I came across the "Castle House" located in Cleveland Heights. The listing said it had been recently sold, so we did a title search to see if we could find the new owners.

We came across a break when we found out that a realtor we used to sell Dominic's mother's home happened to show the house while it was still for sale. We asked a favor of her, and she contacted the listing realtor and found out who the new owners were, along with their phone number. It took several voicemail messages explaining who we were and what we would like to do with their home, and with some patience, we got a call back. Success!

Next step was to schedule a day for the photo shoot that would be good for us, the owners, and the owner of the Jaguar. All based on the weather, and with forecasts being short notice, it was difficult landing a day in between the rain days. Well, the day happened to be one of our 90-degree days in early July. I had come prepared with pictures from the realtor's website that showed all sides of the home. I chose the locations of the shots ahead of time to make sure we could take all the shots at the "golden hour" and while we had good lighting.

It was partly cloudy and 90-degrees. I did not come prepared with something to hydrate myself. Half way through the shoot my face was BEET RED, with sweat running down everywhere. Can I make it to the end? Mike (Tom's son) and Dominic were concerned, and asked me to sit on the stairs several times. Wishing I had a bottle of water, I continued to do the shoot to our last location behind the home.

Finally, we were finished. Tom and Mike loaded up the XJS and left and Dominic pulled up the car with the air conditioning blasting. Getting in I put the seat back and directed the air vents towards me. I told Dominic "Let's go home", and I gradually cooled off. This was a long-winded story, but in all of my years doing the concours poster, this was the most difficult one.

Next comes reviewing the pictures, and sorting them out with the best angles, as well as portrait and landscape orientations. Next is into the software. I use Photoshop to create the poster, using a template I set up years ago. It's the traditional layout every year, to keep consistency for the final product. Several layouts are made with the best choices, and then narrowed down to the final poster to be printed.



Next Dominic shops for quotes to get the best price for printing. Every year the cost goes up, and we get quotes from everyone we can find in our area. This year, Northcoast Litho donated the poster to the club so that we could use that saved expense to give to our designated charities.

The poster is a yearly tradition that is given to all of the Concours d' Elegance participants when they pick up their paperwork at the tent on the day of the show. I have been shooting the poster since 2010 for the club, and I love doing it. Now, what's next year's poster car going to be? It's the 65th Anniversary of the E-type in 2026, so the search is on.

Jaguar Club of Ohio 52nd Annual Concours d'Elegance and European Charity Auto Show

The JCO 52nd Annual Concours d' Elegance and the 6th Annual European Charity Auto Show held on Saturday, August 2nd at Ursuline College was a great success. We celebrated the 50th year anniversary of the XJS automobiles which were all in a row on the show field. The 1988 XJS-C, owned by Thomas Scahel was the poster car for this year.

We had fantastic weather all day Saturday, sunny in the mid 70's, low humidity and no rain. We had 32 pre-registered automobiles and had 33 displayed Jaguars which made a total of 65 Jaguars on the show field. The European Auto Show event had 90 cars on the show field that day. Both the Concours and EAS had a total of 155 automobiles on the show field. This is a record number for us.

I thank all the judges, scorers, runners, gate volunteers, traffic control people, car parkers, tent registration people, 50/50 raffle ticket sellers, door prize co-coordinators and the people that worked in giving out the awards. We had 76 volunteers that have offered to step up and help us for these two shows for that day. The most important person that I give thanks to is Irene Perri for all the pre-registration work, organizing the score sheets and window placards for both shows and all the computer work necessary to hosting and running these two shows. Without her we would have not had these two well organized shows. I thank all of our sponsors for their contributions to help fund the two car shows and making it possible to be able to purchase all the necessary contracts, supplies and items needed for this event. Without the sponsors we could not possibly put these two cars shows on. This event was an excellent example of having top notch judges and volunteers working the shows with their enthusiasm and efforts to make a great show for all that attended. We had Cravings Food truck that provided food for all participants, spectators and lunches for all the judges and volunteers. Door prizes were raffled off to all the car participants. Everyone got a chance to buy and participate in the 50/50 raffle. After the 50/50 raffle winner was announced – Christopher Fredrickson, the awards for the European Auto Show were given out and followed by giving out the Concours d' Elegance awards to the Jaguar winners.

The proceeds of both car shows are going to our charities; **New Directions** - which provides addiction recovery treatment services and rehabilitation programs in Cleveland, Ohio and **Sub-Zero Mission** - which delivers hats, coats, gloves, boots, sleeping bags and other warming items to the homeless in Northeast Ohio and other regions during the winter. At the Concours we collected some winter items to give to Sub-Zero Mission for this upcoming winter season.

We hope that all that attended enjoyed the Concours and European Auto Show and we appreciate the participation of the automobile owners in bringing their fine automobiles to our event. We hope that you will join us again next year on Saturday, August 1, 2026.

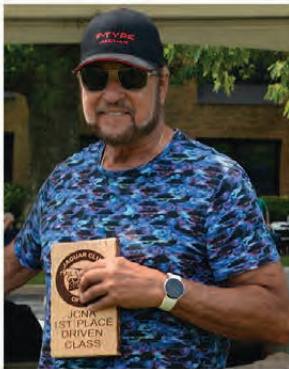

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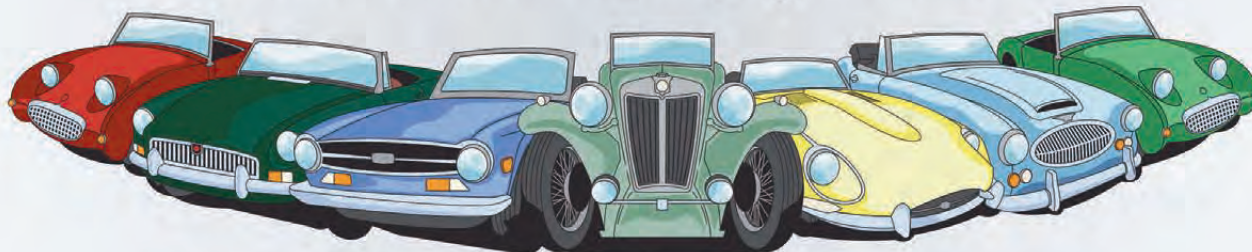
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Dear Fellow Jaguar Enthusiast:

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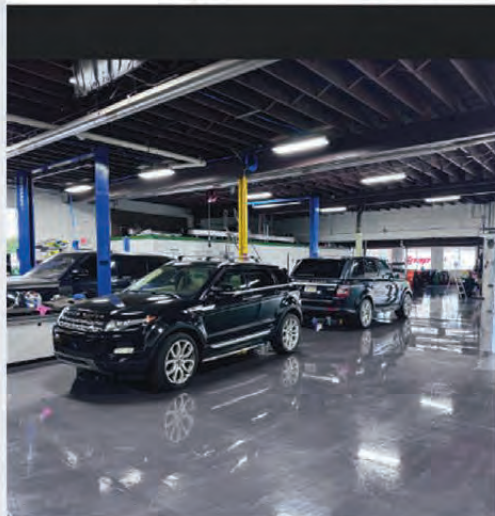


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
