This is a Bylaw change. The current Bylaws say only the club president can authorize a club member to represent the club.

... A proxy consisting of a letter from the president **or authorized officer** of
each JCNA group for which the member is empowered to act must be submitted to the

However, the current Delegate/Proxy form, which has been in effect for many years, says that any authorized officer can authorize a club member to represent the club.

Authorized by (club president or authorized officer)

The Bylaws should be changed to match the form as the club president is not always available to authorize the delegate or proxy holder.
